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religion in science fiction investigates the history of the representations of religion in science fiction literature space travel futuristic societies and non human cultures are traditional themes in science fiction speculating on the societal

impacts of as yet undiscovered technologies is after all one of the distinguishing characteristics of science fiction literature a more surprising theme may be a parallel exploration of religion its institutional nature social functions and the tensions between religious and scientific worldviews steven hrotic investigates the representations of religion in 19th century proto science fiction and genre science fiction from the 1920s through the end of the century taken together he argues that these stories tell an overarching story a metanarrative of an evolving respect for religion paralleling a decline in the belief that science will lead us to an ideal and religion free future science fiction s metanarrative represents more than simply a shift in popular perceptions of religion it also serves as a model for cognitive anthropology providing new insights into how groups and identities form in a globalized world and into how crucial a role narratives may play ironically this same perspective suggests that science fiction as it was in the 20th century may no longer exist

complementing science fiction the early years which surveys science fiction published in book form from its beginnings through 1930 the present volume covers all the science fiction printed in the genre magazines amazing astounding and wonder along with offshoots and minor magazines from 1926 through 1936 this is the first time this historically important literary phenomenon which stands behind the enormous modern development of science fiction has been studied thoroughly and accurately the heart of the book is a series of descriptions of all 1 835 stories published during this period plus bibliographic information supplementing this are many useful features detailed histories of each of the magazines an issue by issue roster of contents a technical analysis of the art work brief authors biographies poetry and letter indexes a theme and motif index of approximately 30 000 entries and general indexes science fiction the gernsback years is not only indispensable for reference librarians collectors readers and scholars interested in science fiction it is also of importance to the study of popular culture during the great depression in the united states most of its data which are largely based on rare and almost unobtainable sources are not available elsewhere

an examination of science fiction editor and author hugo gernsback s career this critical study explores the many ways in which his work influenced the genre it summarizes the science fiction theories of gernsback and his successors considers his efforts to define science fiction both verbally and visually and for the first time offers

detailed studies of his rarest periodicals including technocracy review superworld comics and science fiction plus an analysis of his ground breaking novel ralph 124c 41 a romance of the year 2660 and its influences on a variety of science fiction novels films and television programs is also offered

science fiction represents a diverse community of writers and readers that spans the entire world this collection provides a global tour of the genre with essays about latin american european african arabic indian japanese and chinese science fiction providing insights about how writers around the world have explored and reinvigorated the genre essays by prominent critics from five continents inform about particular cultures and analyze representative texts by authors such as tobias s buckell lourenco mutarelli stanislaw lem masande ntshanga tawfiq al hakim anil menon and cixin liu the contributing scholars examine how national experiences have shaped these narratives which often differ strikingly from anglo american science fiction an introductory survey of foreign language science fiction in the united states endeavors to explain why so many of these texts have remained unknown to anglophone readers an extensive bibliography lists numerous resources for further study of science fiction from various parts of the world

perfect for reference or browsing this volume includes some 80 authors and explores in excerpts of criticism from books essays and reviews their work and influence throughout the coverage is international and the emphasis is on the many rare and insightful comments that are made on these authors who are increasingly accorded literary status and regarded in the critical mainstream

while students and general readers typically cannot relate to esoteric definitions of science fiction they readily understand the genre as a literature that characteristically deals with subjects such as new inventions space robot and aliens this book looks at science fiction in precisely this manner with twenty one chapters that each deal with a subject that is repeatedly addressed in science fiction of recent centuries based on a packet of original essays that the author assembled for his classes the book could serve as a supplemental textbook in science fiction classes but also contains material of interest to science fiction scholars and others devoted to the genre in some cases chapters offer thorough surveys of numerous works involving certain subjects such as imagined vehicles journeys beneath the earth and undersea adventures discovering intriguing patterns in the ways that various writers developed their ideas when comprehensive coverage of ubiquitous topics such as robots aliens and the planet mars is impossible chapters focus on major themes referencing selected texts a conclusion discusses other science fiction subjects that were omitted for various reasons and a bibliography lists additional resources for the study of science fiction in general and the topics of each chapter

a detailed look at the british world of science fiction in the 1950s john wade grew up in the 1950s a decade that has since been dubbed the golden age of science fiction it was a wonderful decade for the genre but not so great for young fans with early television broadcasts being advertised for the first time as unsuitable for children and the inescapable barrier of the x certificate in the cinema barring anyone under the age of sixteen the author had only the radio to fall back on and that turned out to be more fertile for the budding sf fan than might otherwise have been thought which is probably why as he grew older rediscovering those old tv broadcasts and films that had been out of bounds when he was a kid took on a lure that soon became an obsession for him the super accuracy and amazing technical quality of today s science fiction films pale into insignificance beside the radio early tv and b picture films about people who built rockets in their back gardens and flew them to lost planets or tales of aliens who wanted to take over if not our entire world then at least our bodies this book is a personal account of john wade s fascination with the genre across all the entertainment media in which it appeared the sort of stuff he reveled in as a young boy and still enjoys today not only a well researched book grounded in hundreds of sources but also an unmistakable labor of love new york journal of books
